





Progress exams

 - Chapter performance is provided through My Scores
 - Analyzing results from your progress exams will highlight knowledge gaps
- Greenlight Exams are "end of course" exams used to assess readiness
 - These should be the last practice exams taken before sitting for the actual exam

 - Read the question, select an answer
 - Receive immediate feedback and explanation of the correct answer
- Explanations **Off**
 - Take entire exam, receive grade at the end
 - No feedback on performance while testing
 - All questions and explanations may be reviewed upon completion
- Scores on the final exams are the most accurate predictor of test success




